The American Society of International Law is a nonprofit, nonpartisan, educational membership organization founded in 1906 and chartered by the U.S. Congress in 1950. Its mission is to foster the study of international law and to promote the establishment and maintenance of international relations on the basis of law and justice. The Society holds Special Consultative Status to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations and is a constituent society of the American Council of Learned Societies.

The Society's 3,500 plus members come from more than 100 countries and include scholars and practitioners, judges and government officials, representatives of governments and nongovernmental organizations, students, and others interested in international law.

Through its meetings, publications, information services, and outreach programs, ASIL advances international law scholarship and education for international law professionals as well as for broader-policy-making audiences and the public.

#### The New-York Historical Society

The building, designed by York & Sawyer in the Roman Eclectic style, is a designated New York City landmark. #### **Fiona Hill**

The centerpiece of the Gala will be the award presentation to Dr. Fiona Hill, for her distinguished service to our country and her defense of the rule of law. A former National Security Council official and a senior fellow at The Brookings Institution, Dr. Hill is a highly regarded expert on Russian and European affairs whose frank and compelling testimony during the first Trump impeachment inquiry brought her international renown. At a time when public service is often undervalued, she exemplifies the virtues of integrity and professionalism that are decidedly more important today than ever before.



#### **John Avlon**

John Avlon is a senior political analyst and anchor at CNN. He is an award-winning columnist and the author of Independent Nation, Wingnuts, Washington's Farewell and Lincoln & the Fight for Peace as well as co-editor of the Deadline Artists anthologies. He was the editor-in-chief and managing director of The Daily Beast between 2013 and 2018 and served as chief speechwriter for the Mayor of New York. Avlon's essay, "The Resilient City" was selected to conclude Empire City: New York through the Centuries and won acclaim as "the single best essay written in the wake of 9/11." He lives with his wife Margaret Hoover, host of Firing Line on PBS, and their two children - Jack and Toula Lou - in New York.




